Responsibilities:

 Assist with daily operations of autograph sessions, stage scheduling and other on-site events

 Serve as an on-site liaison between Marketing, Operations and Player Services teams to ensure accurate timing and communications of appearances and events

• Engage with fans and volunteers to provide information, answer questions, promote schedule and enforce rules as needed

 Help coordinate on-stage live music performances, including assistance with scheduling, signage, credentials and more

Provide feedback on fan engagement initiatives and help identify opportunities for improvement
